6. What are broadsheets? (The Independent, The Daily Telegraph, The Guardian, The Times)
7. What kind of information can you find there? (more news, serious articles)
8. How many magazines are there in GB? (6500)
9. How do people read newspapers if they don't buy them? (on-line)
10. How many people visit web-sites with newspapers every day? (75000)
11. How do other people learn the news? (listen to the radio)
12. Give the full name of the abbreviation BBC? (Br Broadcasting Corporation)
13. Is the BBC a commercial channel? (No)
14. What other TV channels in GB do you know? (ITV, Channel 4,5-they are commercial)
15. How many hours a week do the British watch TV? (on average 24)
16. How many Br teens have a TV-set in their bedrooms? (46%)
17. What are teens' favourite programs? (*Neighbours, The Simpsons*, sport programs, soap operas like *Eastenders, Friends*)
